Eighth Grade Graduation Policy

- 1. Student must have a **minimum of a** <u>2.0</u> grade point average and have not failed more than one academic class.
- 2. Student must pass **all tests deemed necessary** to graduate as determined by the district.
- 3. The accumulation of more than <u>3</u> days of suspension shall result in the loss of the graduation ceremony privilege.
- 4. School materials lost or damaged must be paid for before graduation. School materials are those items which are provided for the purpose of learning and participating in school activities.
- 5. The accumulation of <u>15</u> (excused or unexcused) **absences** may result in the loss of the graduation ceremony privilege.
- 6. The accumulation of <u>31</u> demerits shall result in the loss of the graduation ceremony privilege.
- 7. **Disruptive behavior** may be grounds for denying graduation ceremony privileges.
- 8. Students enrolling from other schools must provide transcripts verifying eligibility to graduate, per the above conditions.
- Final grade check shall occur at the end of the <u>10th week in the 3rd</u> <u>trimester</u>.
